D1/MANILA/ROME

D2/ROME (D)

Marvel at Gaudí's Sagrada Familia, Parc Guell, Bari Gotic, Museu Picasso, Le Rambla, Casa Milla, Olympic Stadium and all other major attractions

D10/ BARCELONA – ANDORRA LA VELLA – LOURDES (BD)

Breakfast, then a drive to Barcelona to Lourdes and stop at Andorra La Vella for an orientation tour. Continue to Lourdes for your hotel check-in and dinner
